



Habitats and the Local Environment - Get Outside!

A plant or animal's home is called a **habitat**.

Get outside and **be an explorer!** Look out for the habitats near you!

Look out for trees and bushes and **count how many animals you see**. Look carefully, they might be hiding. Don't disturb them!

Can you spot an **insect**?

Clue! Insects have **6** legs.



Can you spot a **bird**?

Clue! Listen for a bird's song.



Can you spot a **squirrel**?

Clue! Squirrels are happy running up trees to look for nuts.

Your turn!

When you get home, you could draw one of the animals you saw. Don't forget to draw its home or **habitat** too!



Remember!

You don't have to go outside to spot animals in their habitats.

Look out the window. What can you see?

Is there a tree? Is anything moving in the tree?

Try looking outside for 5 minutes each day. Do any visitors come back?
