



## Print like Hogarth - Get Creative!

William Hogarth was an artist 300 years ago.  
He made both paintings and a type of art called **prints**.

Prints are like a stamp that can be used over and over again to make copies.  
The 'stamps' that make prints are called **plates**.

Look at this print by William Hogarth of him with his pet dog.



This is the **print**



This is the **plate**,  
what the print is  
made from

**What is the BIG difference between the print and the plate?**

In the print, the dog is on the right. In the plate, the dog is on the left!

Prints are flipped or a **mirror image** of the plate that made them.
