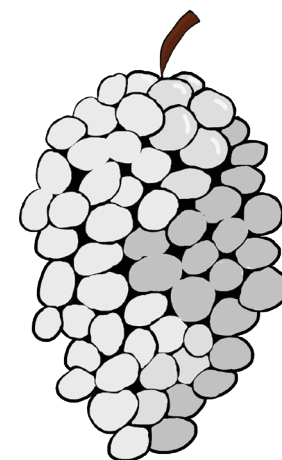
Summers at the Hogarths
