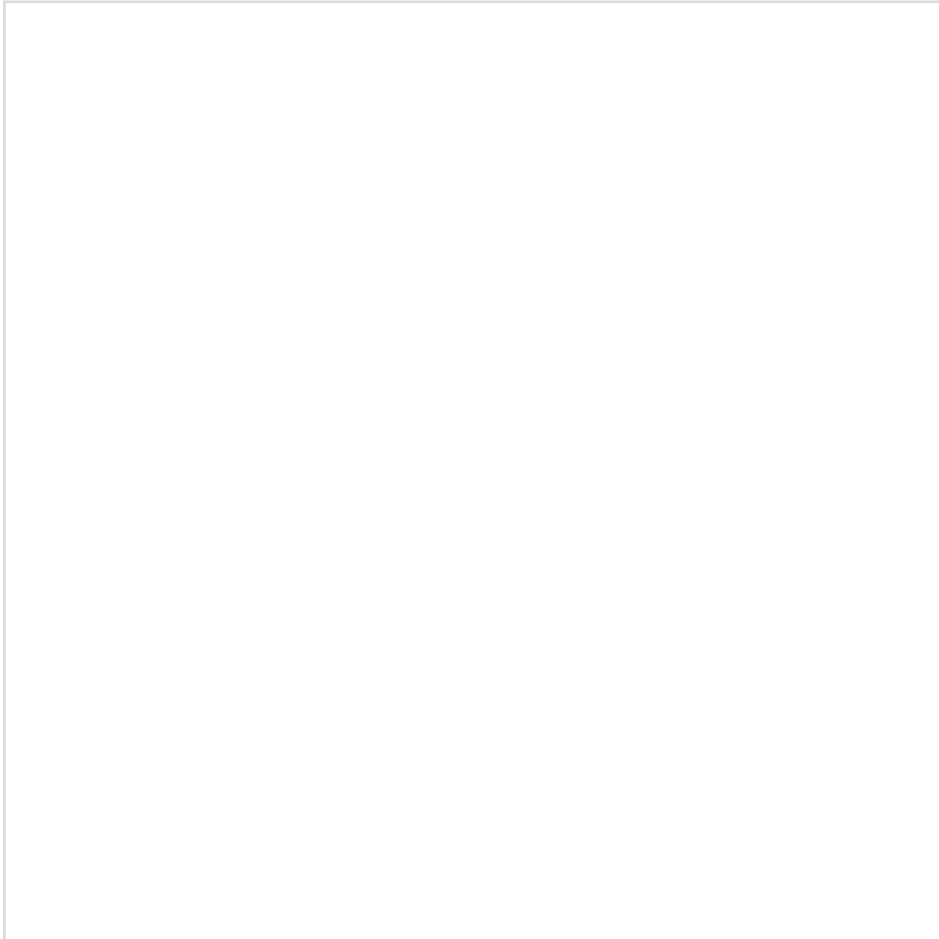

Line of beauty

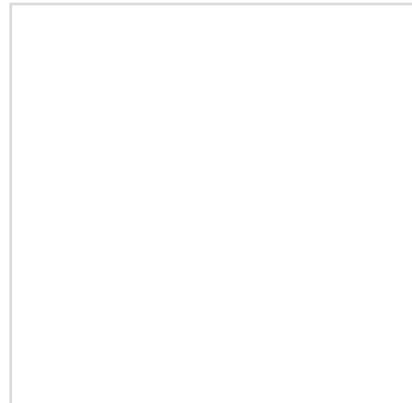
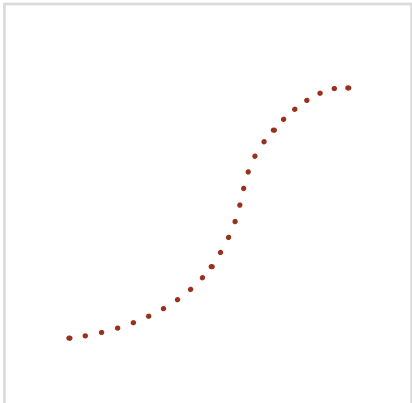


William Hogarth was an artist who liked to use curved lines in his art. He called this the **line of beauty**.
